<b>Bars</b> (i.e. Cereal bars <b>Nutrigrain bars</b> , Granola bars,	
<b>Brownies</b> (brownies of all kinds)	All Personal Purchases-Beer, Wine,
<b>Cake</b> (Cake of all kinds)	Baby wipes
<b>Canned/Processed Meats</b> (Examples: Vienna Sausage, Spam,	BJ's Membership Fee
<b>Candy</b> (candy of all kinds) <b>Fruit Snacks</b> (candy)	Car Payments
<b>Breakfast bars &amp; Breakfast cookies</b> ex: Belvita	Car parts and repairs
<b>Chicken Nuggets (CN LABEL Required)</b>	Cash Back (asking cash return on debit purchases)
<b>Cookies</b> (All cookies i.e. Belvita cookies, <b>Vanilla Wafers</b> )	Classroom Shelves (Capitol Improvements)
<b>Coffee &amp; Coffee Creamer</b>	Classroom Supplies
<b>Corn Dogs (CN LABEL Required)</b>	Clothing
<b>Crab legs, crab meat, artificial crab</b>	Crayons (color pencils and makers)
<b>Fig Newton/Fig Bars Flavored</b>	Diapers, Baby Wipes, Bottles, Bibs, etc.
<b>Flavored Graham crackers</b> ex: Choc Teddy Grahams	Declined Debit Card Receipts (declined payments must be accompanied by proof of approved payment)
<b>Flavored Oatmeal</b> ex: strawberry Flavored Cream of Wheat ex: strawberry cream oatmeal	Delivery Charges/fees(delivery charges of all kinds)
<b>Flavored muffin Mix</b> (over 6 grams of sugar)	EBT/Food Stamp Purchases
<b>Flavored Yogurt</b> (All flavored, Vanilla, Strawberry etc)	Feminine Products Examples: pads, tampons
<b>Frosting and Sprinkles</b>	Folder (binders)
<b>Frozen French Toast</b> (over 6 grams of sugar)	Fuel Surcharges (surcharges of any kind)
	Gas/Fuel (QT, BP, Chevron, etc)
<b>Hot Dogs, Sausage, Links, (CN LABEL Required)</b>	Hand Soap of any kind (foaming, liquid)
<b>Ice Cream</b> (ice cream of any kind, including popsicles)	Hand Soap Dispensers
<b>Jello</b>	Hand Sanitizer
<b>Kraft Mac n Cheese</b> (powdered cheese)	Ink (copier, printer)
<b>Potato Chips</b> (ALL potato chips, Sun Chips, cheese puffs, balls)	Laundry Detergent, Fabric Softener
<b>Power Aid &amp; Gator aid</b>	Lotion (oil, aroma therapy)
<b>Pudding example:</b> Jello pudding cups	Office Supplies (copier, printer, copy paper, paper clips stapler, staples, tape, tape dispenser)
<b>Rice Crispy Treats</b>	
<b>Sausage</b> (All kinds) (CN LABEL Required)	Paint
<b>Soda</b> (All Kinds) example: Sprite, Coke, Pepsi, Orange	Remodeled Cabinets Capital Improvements
<b>Tea</b>	Tissue (facial tissue, bath tissue, palm tissue)
<b>Toaster Pastries</b> (Pop tarts, Toaster Strudels)	Post office Mailing Fees
<b>Veggie Straws</b>	Processing Fees (processing fees of any kind)
<b>Velveeta Cheese</b> (cheese sauce of any kind)	Sam's Club Membership Fee
<b>Whip Cream</b>	Shipping Fees (shipping fees of any kind)

**NOTE:** The USDA has identified costs that are allowable for all institutions that spend Federal funds. **FEDERAL FUNDS should only be spent on creditable items** enforced by CACFP statutory, regulatory, and policy considerations. Allowable costs are bona fide (actual) obligations of an institution. These costs must be necessary, reasonable, authorized, current, properly allocated, and documented.
